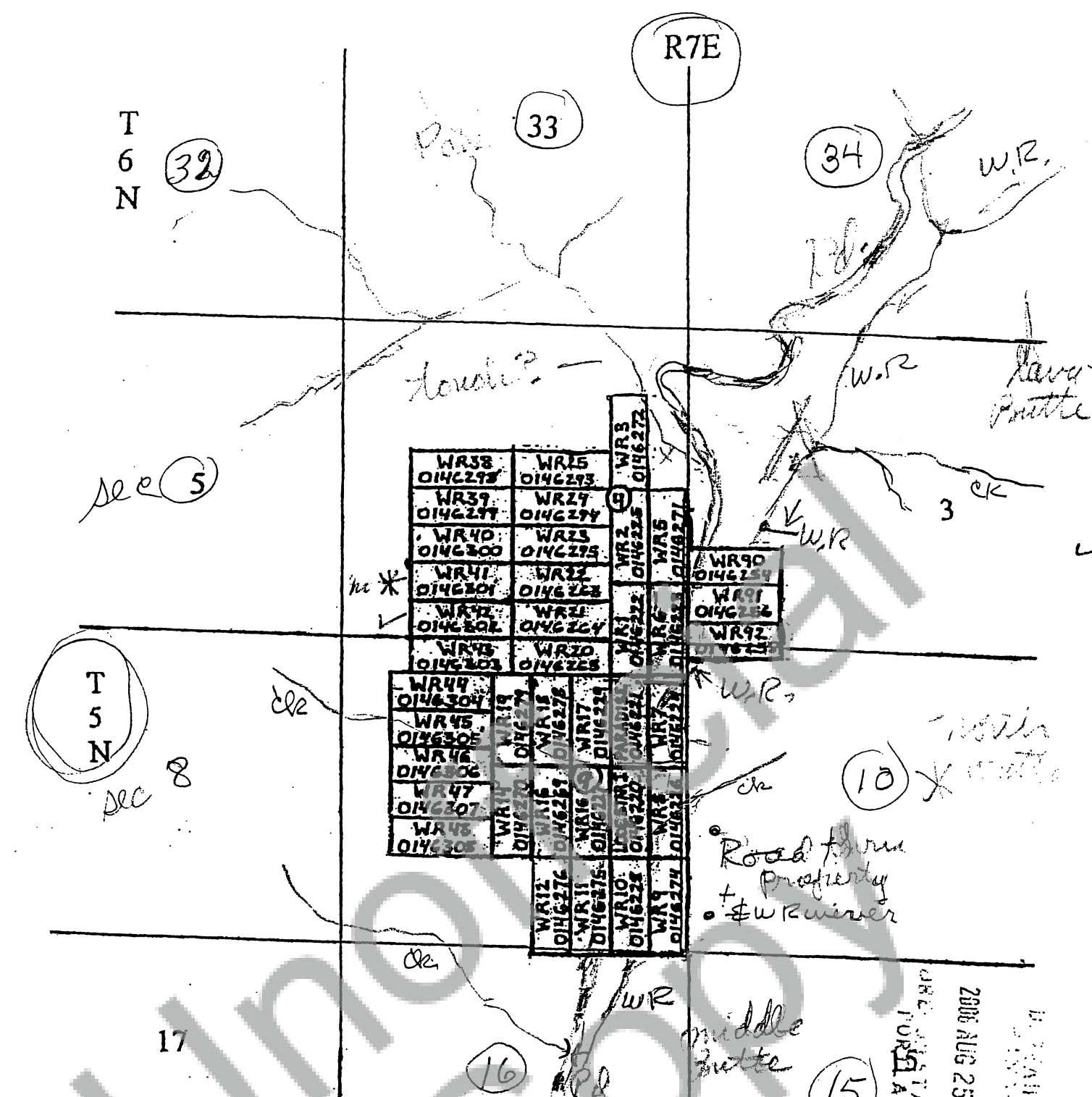


Figure 1. Wind River Mining Co. Claim location map. Skamania County, Washington.
