# CONSENT TO ENCUMBRANCE OF LEASEHOLD INTEREST

- B. Lessee wishes to encumber Lessee's leasehold interest in the Leased Property by assignment for security purposes of Lease in the form of a trust deed ("Leasehold Encumbrance") in favor of Lender to secure Lessee's obligations under a loan agreement, which Leasehold Encumbrance is being recorded concurrently with this Consent to Encumbrance in the official records of Skamania County.

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# Agreement

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Consent to Encumbrance. Lessor hereby consents to the Leasehold Encumbrance, provided however, and upon the express condition, that neither such consent nor the collection of rent from the Lender shall be deemed a waiver or relinquishment for the future of the covenant against assignment or subletting and such conditional acceptance of the Lender as Lessee shall not be deemed a release or waiver from any further performance of the provisions of the Lease from and after the effective date of any assignment.

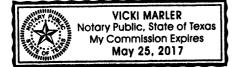

SECTION 1. OCCUPANCY

4.08 Incineration. Because of unpleasant odors and unsightliness, no individual incinerator will be permitted on any lot.

4.09 Fires and Fireplaces. Interior fireplaces, stoves, or other type burner must be fireproofed by use of sparkproof screens. All fires must be extinguished before leaving cabin. No fires shall be lit or meintained outside of any cabin.

4.10 Firearms and Fireworks. Discharging firearms, firecrackers, rockets or any other fireworks within the North Woods area shall be prohibited.

4,11 Commercial Use. No platted lot shall be used for any commercial purpose, except that a Lessee may rent his cabin from time to time, and in such case shall be responsible that his tenants abide by these covenants. 4.12 Motorbikes. #### SECTION 5. IMPROVEMENTS

5.01 Plans Approved. The Lesses further agrees to indemnify and save harmles the Lessor from any loss, cost, suit or expense resulting from Lesses's failure to comply with any of the provisions of any applicable laws, rules or regulations.

7.03 Insurance. Lessee shall obtain fire, casualty and liability insurance at follows:

(a) Fire and casualty insurance in a sufficient amount to cover the replacement oost of any or all improvements upon the lessed premises. MON, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and legal sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, it is hereby mutually covenanted and agreed as follows:

1. Section 5.02 of the Lease is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.02 DUTY. The Lease, at his sole cost and expense, shall at all times keep or cause all improvements, including landscapping, installed pursuant to this lease (regardless of ownership) to be kept in as good condition and repair as priginally constructed or as hereafter put, except for reasonable wear and test. The fitte, or any authorized agency shall have the legal right to inspect the presises and improvements thereon.

The Lesses shall carry, or he shall require his Sublemmes to carry in the joint name of the Lesses, Sublemmes, and asked and Mortgages (if any), a sufficient amount of fire and casualty insurance to cover the replacement cost of any or all improvements that my be demand by fire or other casualty, and public liability insurance (bo the artest not covered under Section 5.03 below) against claims for bodily injury, death or property senses occurring on or about and adjacent to the demined presides. Such policies of insurance shall be with a responsible insurance coverage with provisions for at least ten (10) days notice of cancellation to the Lesses, Lesses shall be responsible for manuscring and insuring that Sublessess maintain appropriate levels of insuring that Sublessess maintain appropriate levels

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insurance coverage, provided, however, the State reserves the right to call for proof of satisfactory insurance at any time.

In the event of fire or casualty damage to any or all of the improvements, any money derived therefrom in dama of loss shall be held in trust and be immediately evailable to and used as soon as reasonably possible by Lesses for rebuilding, repairing or otherwise reinstating the same buildings so destroyed or damaged or such modified plan as shall be previously approved in writing by State.

All other terms and conditions of said Lease, as supplemented, shall remain in full force and effect.

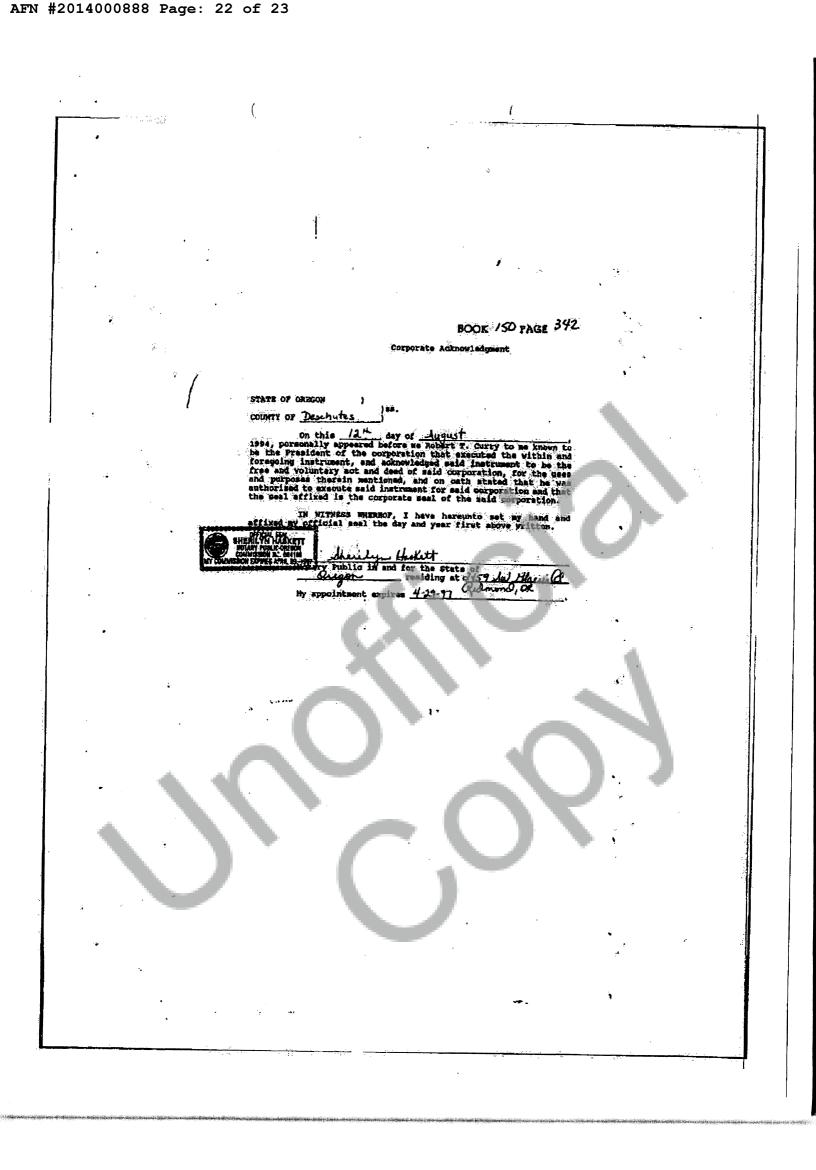
