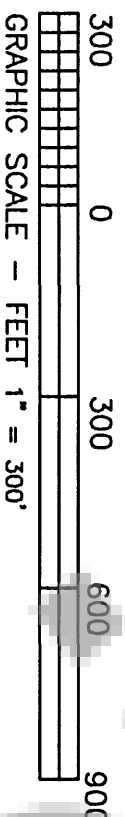
PART OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 AND SW1/4 OF THE NE1/4

AREA BOUNDARY LINE FOLLOWS THE MAIN TOP BREAK
PER 1986 CONGRESSIONAL MAP.

NOTE: FOR PARCEL NO. 03081710140000 ON REFERENCE
SURVEY #4, THE URBAN AREA BOUNDARY LINE IS BASED ON THE
CONGRESSIONAL MAPS DATED SEPTEMBER 1986 AND ESTABLISHED
TO THE BEST OF MY ABILITY. THE CONGRESSIONAL MAP IS FAIRLY
CRUDE AND WITH THE LACK OF INFORMATION OR CRITERIA IT IS
OPEN FOR INTERPRETATION. WE COMPARED THE ELEVATION
DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE TOP BREAK OF THIS AREA TO THE
ELEVATION OF THE WIND RIVERS EDGE AND ALSO SCALED THE
DISTANCE FROM THE TOP BREAK TO THE RIVER. BOTH THE
ELEVATION DIFFERENCE AND DISTANCE TO THE RIVER SEEMS TO
MATCH THE CONGRESSIONAL MAP. WE ASSUMED THE ELEVATION OF
560 FEET AT THE TOP (PER THE MAP) AND THE APPROX. 400'
CONTOUR LINE WHICH CLOSELY MATCHES THE MAP.
WE TRIED TO OBTAIN AS MUCH INFORMATION AS POSSIBLE IN
THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THIS LINE, FROM TALKING WITH OTHER
SURVEYORS, THE COUNTY AND THE GORGE COMMISSION.
I WAS TOLD THERE IS A PRELIMINARY DESCRIPTION FOR THIS AREA,
BUT HAS YET TO BE ADOPTED. WE WERE NOT SUPPLIED WITH THIS
DESCRIPTION, BUT OFFERED TO USE THAT IN DETERMINING THE LINE.

STANDARDS AS SET FORTH IN WAC 332-130-090.

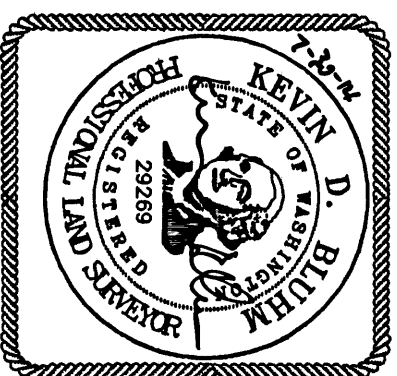

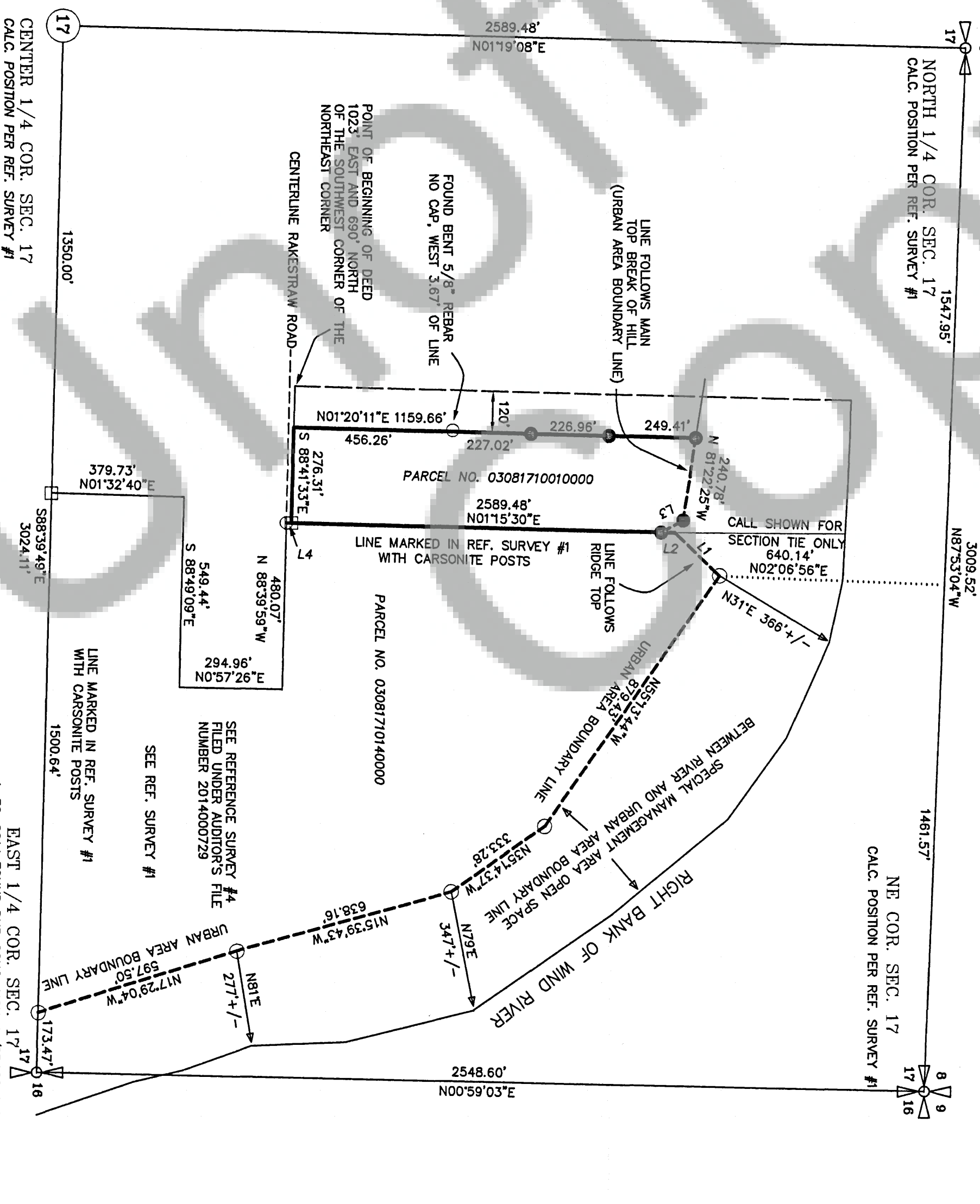
