In accordance with your verbal request, permission is hereby granted for the temperary right to enter on the subject tracts located in downment Lots 5 and 6; MgSW; and in the S.M. Memilton D.L.C. No. 40, all in Section 19, Township 2 North, Range 7 East, W.M., Skammia County, Washington, for sample core drilling, to use the existing EPA access road, and to construct a 14-inch transite unter main adjacent to said road in connection with the development of the Bonneville Lock and Den Project.

You, of course, will have to assume all risk of loss, damage or injury which may result from your use of the area. It is understood that any damage to the BPA's property caused by or resulting from your use of the area may be repaired by the BPA and the actual cost of such repair shall be charged against and be paid by you.

The following conditions also must be complied with:

- 1. The facilities shall be constructed in accordance with USCE drawing No. BDR-7-41/127 (Water Reservoir Site Plan, Access Road, 14-Inch Transmission Main), Revision 2, a copy of which is on file in the Branch of Land, RPA.
- 2. The water main whall be buried with a minimum cover of 24 inches.
- 3. Your contractor shall mintain rafe operating distances from the towers and conductors at all times. Equipment shall not be allowed to go more than 15 feet above ground under the 115-kV line, and 20 feet above ground under the 230-kV line.
- 4. Lu shall mark with permanent type markers the points where the water sain enters and leaves the right-of-way and all angle points within the right-of-way.

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Ltr. Permit to Department of the Army dated NOV 2 9 1976 - Tracter No-R-AR-39, P. 1; BOV-5, etc.

- There shall be no taps off the water main within the transmission line right-of-way.
- 6. Any proposed changes or monifications to the water main shall be referred to BPA for review prior to the changes being made.
- 7. Upon completion of the construction of the water main you shall restore the surface of the right-of-way to a condition entisfactory to BPA, reasonable year and tear, damage by the elements, or circumstances over which the Gorpa has no control excepted.
- 8. The Corps shall maintain and restore BPA's access and maintemance roads to a condition as good as or better than when it communed use thereof. It is further understood that it will be necessary that access to the BPA's transmission lines will be available at all times.
- year supply for the Town of North Bonnaville and, that upon completion of construction, maintenance of the line shall be the responsibility of the Town of North Bonneville. You shall notify MPA prior to the completion of arrangements for turning over the water main.

One print each of BPA drawings Nos. 14822 and 56392 showing the location of the subject tracts are attached hereto.

It is understood that any rights granted you hereunder are subject to existing rights, if any, of other parties and that you will account the provent ownerships.

You, no doubt, are numre of the hazards in placing a metal water line within an electric transmission line right-of-way and will have to assume responsibility for your activities and fabilities.

A permit, essement, or other appropriate document for the operation of these facilities will be entered into between BPA, the Corps, and the rown of North Bonneville prior to the completion of this project.
