The GRANTOR, **Benjamin D. Petiprin, attorney at law**, as present Trustee under that Deed of Trust, as hereinafter particularly described, in consideration of the premises and payment recited below, hereby grants and conveys, without warranty, to: **CNA PROPERTY MANAGEMENT LLC, GRANTEE**, that real property, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, described as follows:

RECITALS:

1. This conveyance is made pursuant to the powers, including the power of sale, conferred upon said Trustee by that certain Deed of Trust between NEVA I BROWN, PRESUMPTLVELY SUBJECT TO THE COMMUNITY INTEREST OF HER SPOUSE IF MARRIED, as Grantor, to FIRST AMERICAN TITLE INSURANCE COMPANY, as Trustee, and GENWORTH FINANCIAL HOME EQUITY ACCESS, INC. as Lender, Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc., as Beneficiary, dated 6/2/2011, recorded 6/16/2011, as Instrument No. 2011178464, in Book/Reel , Page/Frame , records of Skamania County, Washington.

Said Deed of Trust was executed to secure, together with other undertakings, the payment of one promissory note in the sum of \$330,000.00 with interest thereon, according to the terms thereof, in favor of GENWORTH FINANCIAL HOME EQUITY ACCESS, INC. as Lender, Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc. and to secure any other sums of money which might become due and payable under the terms of said Deed of Trust.

Default having occurred in the obligations secured and/or covenants of the Grantor, as set forth in Notice of Trustee's Sale described below, which by the terms of the Deed of Trust make operative the power to sell, the thirty-day advance Notice of Default was transmitted to the Grantor, or his successor in interest, and a copy of said Notice was posted or served in accordance with law.

Champion Mortgage LLC as servicer for and on behalf of Nationstar Mortgage LLC d/b/a Champion Mortgage Company , being then the holder of the indebtedness secured by said Deed of Trust, delivered to said Trustee a written request directing said Trustee or his authorized agent to sell the described property in accordance with law and the terms of said Deed of Trust.

The defaults specified in the “Notice of Default” not having been cured, the Trustee, in compliance with the terms of said Deed of Trust, executed and recorded on 12/1/2014, in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, a "Notice of Trustee's Sale" of said property as Auditor's File No. 2014002067

The Trustee, in its aforesaid "Notice of Trustee's Sale," fixed the place of sale as, At the main entrance to the Skamania County Courthouse, 240 Vancouver Ave., Stevenson, WA 98648, a public place, on 3/6/2015 at 10:00 AM, and in accordance with law caused copies of the statutory "Notice of Trustee's Sale" to be transmitted by mail to all persons entitled thereto and either posted or served prior to 90 days before the sale; further, the Trustee caused a copy of said "Notice of Trustee's Sale" to be published once between the thirty-fifth and twenty-eighth day before the date of sale, and once between the fourteenth and seventh day before the date of sale in a legal newspaper in each county in which the property or any part thereof is situated: and further, included in this Notice, which was transmitted to or served upon the Grantor or his successor in interest, a "Notice of Foreclosure" in substantially the statutory form.
