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The term "indebtedness" as used in this Deed of Trust, shall mean the debt to Credit Union described above, including interest thereon as described in the credit agreement, plus (a) any armounts expended or advanced by Credit Union to discharge Grantor's obligations hereunder, and (b) any expenses incurred by Credit Union or Trustee to enforce Grantor's obligations hereunder, with interest thereon at the rate of Agreement.

The credit agreement describing the repayment terms of the Indebtedness, and any notes, agreements, or documents given to renew, extend or substitute for the credit agreement originally issued is referred to as "the Agreement." The rate of interest on the Agreement is subject to indexing, adjustment, renewal,

2. Possession and Maintenance of the Property.

2.2 Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to

preserve its value.

2.3 Nuisance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof including without limitation removal or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or gravel or rock

2.4 Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Credit Union shall consent if Grantor makes arrangements satisfactory to Credit Union to replace any improvement which Grantor proposes to remove with one of at least equal value. "Improvements" shall include all existing and future buildings, structures, and parking facilities.
2.5 Credit Union's Right to Enter. Credit Union, its agents and representatives, may enter upon the Property at all reasonable times to attend to

2.6 Compliance with Governmental Requirement. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Credit Union in writing prior to doing so and Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized.

2.7 Duty of Protect. Grantor may do all other acts, allowed by law, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the security.

2.8 Construction Loan. If some or all of the proceeds of the loan creating the Indebtedness are to be used to construct or complete construction of any improvement on the Property, the Improvement shall be completed within six months from the date of this Deed of Trust and Grantor shall pay in full all costs and expenses in connection with the work.

2.9 Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property has not been and will not be, during the period this deed remains a lien on the Property, used for the creation, manufacture, treatment, storage, or disposal of any hazardous substance, as defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, and other applicable federal and state laws or regulations and amendments. Grantor authorizes Credit Union and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Credit Union may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this paragraph. Credit Union's inspections and tests shall be for Credit Union's purposes only and shall not be for the benefit or create any duty or liability to Grantor or any third party. Grantor agrees to indemnify and hold Credit Union harmless against any and all claims and losses including attorney fees resulting from a breach of this paragraph, which shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and satisfaction of this Deed of Trust.

3.2 Right to Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within 15 days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within 15 days after Grantor has notice of the filling, secure the discharge of the lien or deposit with Credit Union, cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Credit Union evidence of payment of the laxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate county official to deliver to Credit Union at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

3.4 Notice of Construction. 4. Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard all-risk extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value basis covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a mortgagee's loss payable clause in favor of Credit Union. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Credit Union. Grantor shall deliver to Credit Union certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of 10 days' written notice to Credit Union.

4.2 Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds or restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Credit Union. Credit Union shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or relimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been paid out within 180 days after their receipt and which Credit Union has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to prepay first accrued interest and then principal of the Indebtedness. If Credit Union hads any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

4.3 Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Deed of Trust at any trustee's or other sale

4.5 Association of Unit Owners. In the event the Real Property has been submitted to unit ownership pursuant to a Unit Ownership Law, or similar law for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of Real Property, the insurance may be carried by the association of unit owners in Grantor's behalf, and the proceeds of such insurance may be paid to the association of unit owners for the purpose of repairing or reconstructing the Property. 4.6 Insurance Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of insurance premiums, which reserves shall be created by monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the insurance premiums to be paid. 5. Expenditure by Credit Union.

If Grantor falls to comply with any provision of this Deed of Trust, including the obligation to maintain the prior Indebtedness in good standing as required by Section 17, the Credit Union may at its option on Grantor's behalf pay amounts to cure any default in the prior indebtedness and any amount that it expends in so doing shall be added to the Indebtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable in accordance with the terms of the indebtedness. The rights provided for in this section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Credit Union may be entitled on account of the default. Credit Union shall not by taking the required action cure the default so as to bar it from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

6. Warranty; Defense of Title.

6.1 Title. Grantor warrants that it holds marketable title to the Property in fee simple free of all encumbrances other than those set forth in Section 7 or in any policy of title insurance issued in favor of Credit Union in connection with the Deed of Trust.

6.2 Defense of Title. Subject to the exceptions in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Credit Union or Trustee under this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense.

c) Credit Union shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Credit Union's costs, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Credit Union may require any tenant or other user to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Credit Union. If the Income is collected by Credit Union irrevocably designates Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Credit Union in response to Credit Union's demand shall satisfy the obligation for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Credit Union may exercise its right, under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Credit Unions shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

14.3 Notice of Sale. Credit Union shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten days before the time of the sale or disposition.

14.5 Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Credit Union Institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Credit Union shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Credit Union that are necessary at any time in Credit Union's opinion for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate of the Agreement. Expenses covered by this paragraph include (without limitation) all attorney fees incurred by Credit Union whether or not there is a lawsuit, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee. Attorney fees include those for bankruptcy proceedings and anticipated post-judgement collection actions.

15. Notice.

Any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective on the

16.1 Successors and Assigns. Credit Union shall have the right to exercise this power of attorney only after default by Grantor and may decline to exercise this power, as Credit Union may see fit.

16.3 Annual Reports. If the Property is used for purposes other than grantor's residence, within 60 days following the close of each fiscal year of Grantor, Grantor shall furnish to Credit Union a statement of net operating income received from the Property during Grantor's previous fiscal year in such details as Credit Union shall require. "Net operating income" shall mean all cash receipts from the Property less all cash expenditures made in connection with the property.

d) If located in Utah, this instrument is a Trust Deed executed in conformity with the Utah Trust Deed Act, UCA 57-1-19 et seq.

16.8 Waiver of Homestead Exemption. Borrower hereby waives the benefit of the homestead exemption as to all sums secured by this Deed of

16.10 Substitute Trustee. Credit Union, at Credit Union's option, may from time to time appoint a successor trustee to any Trustee appointed hereunder by an instrument executed and acknowledged by Credit Union and recorded in the office of the Recorder of the county where the Property is located. The instrument shall contain the name of the original Credit Union, Trustee, and Borrower, the book and page where this Deed of Trust is recorded, and the name and address of the successor trustee. The successor trustee shall, without conveyance of the Property, succeed to all the title, powers, and duties conferred upon the Trustee herein and by applicable law. This procedure for substitution of trustee shall govern to the exclusion of all other provisions for substitution.

16.11 Statement of Obligation. If the Property is in California, Credit Union may collect a fee not to exceed the statutory maximum for furnishing the statement of obligation as provided by Section 2943 of the Civil Code of California.

16.12 Severability. If any provision in this Deed of Trust shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.
