NARRATIVE
THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO LOCATE AND MARK THE WEST
AND SOUTH LINE OF THE "WEYERHAEUSER COLUMBIA TIMBERLANDS,
LLC TRACT" CITED IN SECTION 14 FOR FUTURE LOGGING PURPOSES. A
RANDOM CONTROL TRAVERSE WAS RAN FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER,
NORTH TO THE CENTER SOUTH 1/16 AND THEN WEST TO THE SOUTH
1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 14. THIS TRAVERSE WAS ORIENTED TO THE
BEARING OF N 00°01'17" W, BETWEEN THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND
THE CENTER SOUTH 1/16 CORNER AS SHOWN IN A UNRECORDED
SURVEY BY ALFRED OPDAHL (1969), ON FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT
OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

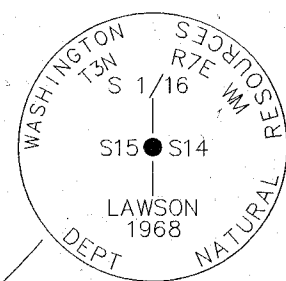

CAP (SEE NOTE) AS SHOWN IN U.R.S.
BY ALFRED OPDAHL (1969), STAMPED
AS SHOWN AND REFERENCED AS
FOLLOWS:
40" FIR WITH HEALED BLAZE,
N48°E, 64.6' TO NAIL IN SIDE CENTER
30" FIR WITH HEALED BLAZE,
N42°W, 22.0' TO NAIL IN SIDE CENTER
METAL "T" POST S42°E, 4.8'
(SEE BOOK J, PAGE 153 FOR
REFERENCES)

NOTE
THE DNR MONUMENT FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH WAS
FOUND LAYING BENT OVER AND LEANING AT A 90°
ANGLE POINTING DOWN THE CREEK, MOST LIKELY
FROM A WASHOUT. THE CREEK HAS A 3' DEEP
CHANNEL AND THE CORNER LIES ON THE EDGE OF
THE SOUTH BANK OF THE CHANNEL. I STRAIGHTENED
THE IRON ROD THE CONCRETE MONUMENT WITH BRASS
CAP WAS ATTACHED TO AND PULLED RECORD
DISTANCES OFF OF BOTH EXISTING BEARING TREES TO
RESTORE THIS CORNER. WE ALSO DUG A BENCH IN
THE DIRT AND RIVER ROCK ON THE NORTH SIDE OF
THE MONUMENT SO WE COULD BUILD UP A ROCK
MOUND TO PROTECT THE MONUMENT FROM FUTURE
WASH OUTS COMING DOWN THE CREEK.

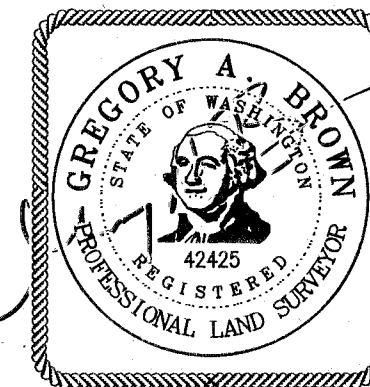
