ARSENIC IN DRINKING WATER EXCEEDS EPA LIMIT**

Declarations as Property Recordings may be completed by the property owner, or by property owner representative, presented to SCCDD, then submitted to the recorder at the Skamania County Auditor's Office.

The facility on the property at the address 51 Bone Road, Stevenson, is served by an water source in which arsenic has been detected. Certified laboratory analysis of untreated drinking water collected on 12/17/2019 found arsenic at 43 ppb from water source DOE #AKO-053. Although there are no regulatory requirements for private individual wells, Skamania County Community Development Department recommends water treatment to reduce the amount of arsenic to a level below the EPA's maximum contaminant level of 10 ppb.
