

NARRATIVE:

--THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MARK AND MONUMENT THE PROPERTY LINES AS SHOWN PER THE REQUEST OF SKEELE AND SONS AND KEN JOHNSTON.

--FOR CONTROL I HELD THE MONUMENTS AS SHOWN IN THE MONUMENT NOTES.

--THE BEARINGS ARE NAD 83 (CORS) EPOCH 2010, WASHINGTON SOUTH ZONE BASED ON GPS OBSERVATIONS CONSTRAINED TO NGS CORS STATION P429 (PID DR5455) LATITUDE 45°40'34.04468", LONGITUDE 121°52'38.43679. DISTANCES SHOWN ARE GROUND.

SECTION 20:

--THE W 1/4 CORNER AS ESTABLISHED IN SURVEY BOOK 1, PAGE 56 IS MISSING. I REESTABLISHED IT AT THE RECORD BEARING AND DISTANCE FROM MONUMENT NO. 1 PER SURVEY BOOK 1, PAGE 56. I THEN SUBDIVIDED THE SW 1/4 ACCORDING TO THE 2009 MANUAL OF SURVEYING INSTRUCTIONS.

TAYLOR TRACT:

--THIS TRACT IS THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SW 1/4 OF THE SW 1/4 LYING SOUTH OF CARSON CREEK.

STIG TRACT:

--THIS TRACT IS THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SW 1/4 OF THE SW 1/4.

JOHNSTON

--I ESTABLISHED THE SOUTHEAST CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE NW 1/4 OF THE SW 1/4 AT THE DEEDED DISTANCE [330.00'] FROM THE SOUTH 1/6 CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 19 & 20. I ESTABLISHED THE NORTHEAST CORNER AT THE DEEDED DISTANCE [990.00'] FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF THE SW 1/4.

SKEELE AND SONS

--FOR THE WEST LINE I HELD THE EAST LINE OF THE JOHNSTON TRACT. FOR THE SOUTHERLY SOUTHEAST CORNER I SET A POINT ON LINE NORTH OF CARSON CREEK.

--THE LINES SHOWN AS HATCHED ARE MARKED WITH RED & WHITE FLAGGING ON TRUE LINE AND THE TREES WITHIN 10' OF LINE WERE MARKED WITH BLUE TREE MARKING PAINT AT CHEST HEIGHT.

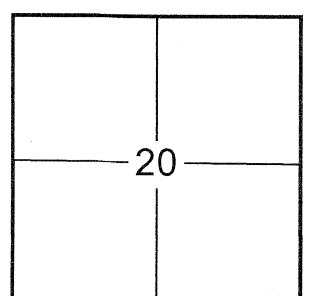

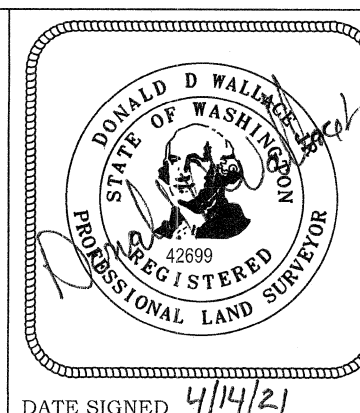
