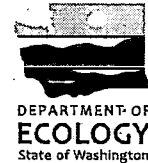

Provisions

Measurements, Monitoring, Metering and Reporting

An approved measuring device must be installed and maintained for each of the sources identified by this water right in accordance with the rule "Requirements for Measuring and Reporting Water Use", WAC 173-173.

WAC 173-173 describes the requirements for data accuracy, device installation and operation, and information reporting. It also allows a water user to petition the Department of Ecology for modifications to some of the requirements.

Water Use Efficiency

The water right holder is required to maintain efficient water delivery systems and use of up-to-date water conservation practices consistent with RCW 90.03.005.

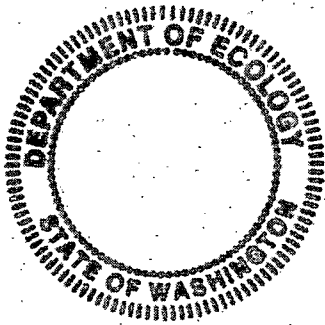
This water right and Water Right S2-30648 share a common point of diversion and distribution system. The Department of Ecology cannot guarantee the availability or delivery of quantities authorized under this right due to existing water system maintenance and delivery agreements between the water right holder and the USFWS. Resolution of issues involving the infrastructure or delivery of water is a private matter and is the responsibility of the parties sharing the system.

Schedule and Inspections

Department of Ecology personnel, upon presentation of proper credentials, shall have access at reasonable times, to the project location, and to inspect at reasonable times, records of water use, wells, diversions, measuring devices and associated distribution systems for compliance with water law.

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for non-use of water as provided in Chapter 90.14 RCW.
