



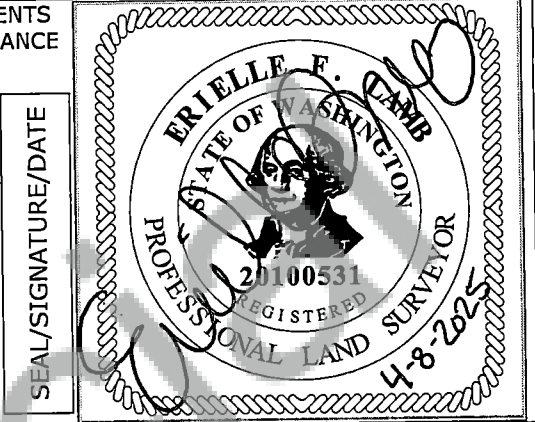

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LAND CORNER RECORD ATTACHMENT

(1897) Deputy Surveyor Christian Anderson under government contract #503 set the closing corner of S19 & S30 only of T4N R5E of the Willamette Meridian. Intersected the west boundary of T4N R4E 5.38 chains north of the section corner of S19, S24, S25, & S30. Set a fir post 3' long, 4" square, 24" in the ground for the closing corner of S19 & S30 marked "CCT4NR5E" on east, S19 on the north, and S30 on the south face, with 4 groves on the north and 2 groves on the south face from which:

A 38" Fir, N63°E, 67 links distance, marked "T4NR5ES19BT".

A 11" Maple, S40°E, 44 links distance, marked "T4NR5ES30BT".

(Unrecorded) Corner visited by the U.S. Forest Service at a unrecorded date. Note finding a cedar post and iron pipe 12" above the ground in good condition from 1934. The following bearing references were recorded:

48" Fir Snag, S35°E, 57'5".

38" Fir Snag, N63°E, 44'2".

Boundary sign posted at intersection of section line and road. Corner is 1460' north of road and about 250' north of summit of hill.

Evidence:

(March 2025) R. Ellis of the U.S. Forest Service Columbia Land Zone recovered the closing corner to S19 & S30 of T4N R5E of the Willamette Meridian. Found 1/2" iron pipe with no cap, 16" above the ground with a T-Iron post 1" west of the pipe. All bearing trees were dead snags during last recorded visit and no bearing tree were recovered during our visit.

Perpetuation:

Set 5/8"x24" rebar with "WA LS#20100531" pink plastic cap, South, 4.0' distance. Aluminum guard post set behind rebar reference with land survey monument and bearing tree tag signs attached.

Set 5/8"x24" rebar with "WA LS#20100531" pink plastic cap, North, 2.2' distance. Aluminum guard post set behind rebar reference with land survey monument and bearing tree tag signs attached.

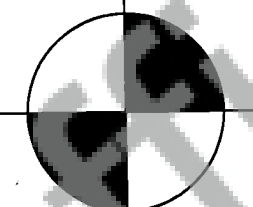
NOTE: This corner is junior to corners set in T4N R4E and was established with a tie in one direction only and set at record bearing (See "2009 Manual of Surveying Instructions", 7-45). US Forest Service posted boundary does not hold this corner for the Township boundary.
