


NARRATIVE
THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO POST THAT PORTION OF THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 8 AS SHOWN FOR THE "POPE RESOURCES TRACT" CITED. FIELD WORK CONSISTED OF RUNNING A RANDOM CONTROL TRAVERSE FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 8 TO THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 8. THIS TRAVERSE WAS THEN ROTATED TO THE RECORD BEARING OF SOUTH 89°47'00" EAST AS SHOWN ON THE 1923 GLO PLAT OF TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 6 EAST, THE FIELD WORK OF WHICH FOR SAID PLAT WAS PERFORMED BY CHESTER W. PECORE UNDER GROUP NUMBER 19, SAID PLAT BEING THE BASIS OF BEARING FOR THIS SURVEY. NO NEW MONUMENTS WERE ESTABLISHED DURING THIS SURVEY.




SECTION DIAGRAM

SKAMANIA COUNTY, WA.


BEARINGS BASED


